

Renewal of City of Oak Point, Texas Resolution No.2024-05-15R and Denton ISD

SUMMARY:

-This item requests approval of the Renewal of the agreement of the City of Oak Point, Texas Resolution No. 2024-05-15R and the Denton Independent School District whereas City of Oak Point shall provide Denton ISD with two (2) certified police officers to serve as school resource officers (SROs) assigned to Rodriguez Middle School and Cross Oaks Elementary School.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

-The Denton ISD Board of Trustees have approved similar agreements with the City of Denton, Denton County Sheriff's Department, Town of Little Elm, and the City of Aubrey to provide SROs to our campuses in their jurisdiction.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: -

-This is a service provided by The City of Oak Point to assist our schools in Oak Point's jurisdiction with School Resource Officers.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

-This MOU establishes and delineates the mission of the School Resource Officer Program, herein referred to the SRO program, as a joint cooperative effort. Additionally, the MOU formalizes relationships between the participating entities in order to foster an efficient and cohesive program that will build a positive relationship between Police Officers and the youth of our community in addition to reducing crime committed by juveniles and young adults.
