Spring Benchmark Testing

AimsworldPlus is an online assessment, data management, and reporting system that provides national and local performance and growth norms for the screening and progress monitoring of math and reading skills for all students in Kindergarten through Grade 8.

AimsworldPLUS testing will begin at Browning Middle School on Monday, May 9th and continue through Friday, May 13th with all three grade levels taking part in the testing. Makeup testing will occur the following week from May 16th to the 20th. Below are the Fall and Winter Benchmark testing data.

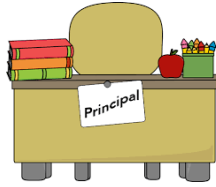
