Junior High Awning

I have mentioned this project before, it will be part of this year's maintenance grant. I do not have any pricing at this time, but I will have it before the meeting to present.

Demo Update

After approval of Triple A Asbestos proposals the abatement of Washington school will begin on March 18th. This should take about three weeks. They will then move on to Lincoln. Once the asbestos has been removed we will move closer to the demolition. The plan is to open bids on April 22nd and bring them to the board for approval. There will be more information on this in the Superintendent report and I can help with any questions when it is presented.

High School Locks

We currently have four locks that are not working, they still lock, just not properly. These four were found to be defective and the company is replacing them. They should be installed in the next week or so. I also wanted to let you know that the new locks have a 10 year warranty.

School Auction

The auction at Washington school is complete. The auction brought in \$58,198.00. The District received \$40,238.60. The remaining amount went to commission and a \$500 advertising fee. Lincoln school is online now and will run through April 6^{th} .
