# Arts Education Grants \$15,000 – Far West Fibers & Young Audiences of Oregon & SW Washington

Beaverton recycling company Far West Fibers, in collaboration with Young Audiences of Oregon & SW Washington, awarded \$15,000 in competitive grants this year to be distributed among eight Beaverton schools to fund arts programs at each school. The eight schools are Aloha-Huber Park K-8, Jacob Wismer, McKay, Montclair, Oak Hills, Scholls Heights and West Tualatin View elementary schools, and Health & Science School.

Some of the events planned for this school year include an International Fair, "Fiesta Night" performances, a cultural week featuring African music by Obo Addy Legacy Project and a dance workshop by BodyVox.

This is the 24<sup>th</sup> consecutive year that Far West Fibers has partnered with Young Audiences to bring exciting art education experiences to elementary schools in the Beaverton School District.
