SUBJECT:

Approve the 3rd year of a 5 year extension agreement with Blackboard, Inc. to provide a Managed Hosting Solution and course delivery for their on-line learning management software used by the College to support our on-line classes.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the 3rd year of a 5 year extension agreement with Blackboard, Inc. to provide a Managed Hosting Solution and course delivery for their on-line learning management software used by the College to support our on-line classes at a cost of \$88,000.00 for 2020.

BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

Blackboard, Inc. is currently hosting the College's critical online courses and programs in a redundant and secure cloud-based environment. Blackboard, Inc. also manages all aspects of server hardware, backups, and operating system administration. The current agreement started 9-1-17 and runs through 8-31-2022. The cost of the initial year was \$145,000.00. Year two was \$85,000.00. This is the 3rd year and the cost for year 3 is \$88,000.00. This 5 year agreement represents a savings of \$101,000.00 to the College over a year by year agreement and was purchased under the Choice Partners cooperative. Purchases made under Choice Contract # 17/026KH-08 satisfy all State of Texas bid requirements.






