Discussion from Klang included heating problems being worked on and LAKE Foundation will be replaced; working on security system and LAKE Foundation has funded cameras to be installed; John Sesin is the main contact and is on top of it.

Recommended Social Emotional Learning Curriculum, part of Responsive Classroom.

This curriculum goes with responsive classroom; is spendy; finance committee said yes; please bring it to the board.

Small maintenance fee that will be built into the next budget. Teachers using it during morning meeting time; 4th grade and down; middle school using twice a month during advisory. Specific age appropriate standards that go along with it; over 80% of our students show need for intervention; major concern is this will help sift out matters.

Cost is \$8,364. A \$2,400 Credit with Responsive Classroom to be applied as well as funds from Esser. The Finance Committee has already approved but this needs to go to the board due to the high price tag. We are checking on the price of yearly consumables and will be building this into

Looking forward to do SAEBERS; Community Engagement Committee - spaghetti dinner was well attended and kids had a blast; trying to have a family night with Title 1; enough family and fun things; Santa's workshop, CLC has invited 7-8 grades to watch Sherlock Holmes.

Amaya - applied for a grant to support MTSS coordination in both of our programs; will find out in January; three-year grant of \$375,000; allocate \$125,000 per year - additional staff support for MTSS. Benefit for a position that will specifically coordinate that position; funds for staff support across the board for teachers to work on MTSS well. Planning to measure student engagement-through meetings with staff and break out sessions; every student gets a grad plan that lists all of their credits they have and what they need. Get a target graduation date; learning coaches are going to meet with students once a year to discuss post secondary goals and graduation goals. Can measure if students are meeting their graduation date or not.

Additional funds for Esser for extended day summer school programs - use with online program; doing some awesome field trips to BWCA or Osprey Wilds.
