Re: Exceptional Child Online Professional Development System

As a district we are constantly trying to provide quality professional development for all staff. To this end, we have included in the Harlem Support Staff Collective Bargaining Agreement. Article 15, Section 14 states:

ParaEducators will be required to attend a paid professional development two (2) times per year outside of the workday. A time sheet shall be available and forwarded to the payroll department. The Director of Student Support Services will determine this professional development. A newly hired ParaEducator shall be provided two (2) days of in-service training prior to assuming their duties.

Due to the fact the role of ParaEducator can look different depending on the position, finding quality professional development that meets the needs of each staff member can be challenging. Student Support Services have evaluated a few companies that offer online professional development specifically for individuals who work with students with exceptionalities.

After analyzing these products, Heidi Lange and Shannon Rice are recommending that we purchase Exceptional Child Online Professional Development Services.
