

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE FRISCO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL
DISTRICT APPROVING THE REVISION OF
ATTENDANCE ZONES FOR GRIFFIN MIDDLE
SCHOOL, HUNT MIDDLE SCHOOL, AND TRENT
MIDDLE SCHOOL AND THE RETIREMENT OF
STALEY MIDDLE SCHOOL**

WHEREAS, Frisco Independent School District ("Frisco ISD" or the "District") is committed to providing high-quality education to students within its community;

WHEREAS, Frisco ISD reviewed district-wide data, which showed declining enrollment projections for multiple middle schools in Frisco ISD;

WHEREAS, with projected enrollment declines, Frisco ISD expects to have insufficient middle school student enrollment numbers to sustain 19 middle school campuses by 2027;

WHEREAS, Frisco ISD can meet the needs of district middle school students while also being good stewards of taxpayer dollars by reducing the number of Frisco ISD middle school campus sites from 19 to 18 beginning in the 2026-2027 School Year;

WHEREAS, Frisco ISD compared the building capacity and needs of its middle school campuses;

WHEREAS, upon comparison of current middle school building capacity and needs, Staley Middle School had the highest degree of building needs and repair options would require the long term displacement of Staley Middle School students for the construction projects necessary to address such needs;

WHEREAS, the Board determined it is in the best interest of Frisco ISD students and citizens to amend the attendance zones of Griffin Middle School, Hunt Middle School, and Trent Middle School beginning in the 2026-2027 school year and to retire Staley Middle School at the end of the 2025-2026 school year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE FRISCO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:

- 1) The above and foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Resolution.
- 2) The Board approves revision to student attendance zones for Griffin Middle School, Hunt Middle School, and Trent Middle School as described on **Exhibit A** attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for Frisco ISD students beginning in the 2026-2027 School Year.

- 3) The Board approves the retirement of the Staley Middle School following the conclusion of the 2025-2026 School Year.
- 4) The Board does hereby delegate authority and authorize the Superintendent of Schools to take such actions as required by the law and/or by the Texas Education Agency to effectuate the revised campus attendance zones and campus retirement described and approved herein.
- 5) The Board directs the Superintendent to ensure that in effectuating the revised campus attendance zones and campus retirement described and approved herein, Frisco ISD Administration develop a plan that includes, but is not limited to, consideration of:
 - a) Student transition support, including campus culture orientation and/or welcome activities;
 - b) Retention of Staley Middle School staff in good standing within Frisco ISD for the 2026-2027 School Year, wherein staff are reasonably assured a comparable position within the District for which the relevant employee is qualified;
 - c) Equal access to transportation services for students currently zoned to Staley Middle School to their newly zoned campuses at Griffin Middle School, Hunt Middle School, or Trent Middle School; and
 - d) Recognition of the Staley Middle School legacy and significance to the Frisco ISD community.
- 6) It is officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was considered was open to the public and public notice of the time, place and purposes of the meeting was given and posted as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, as amended.
