Background Information

MISD's approach to College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) has historically provided students with a bevy of opportunities, earning very high scores on TEA's annual accountability ratings, while preparing students for life after high school. TEA has implemented significant changes to CCMR, and MISD has evaluated plans to continue offering those same opportunities to students to continue achieving highly and to maintain accountability. This presentation will highlight the changes and plan for students graduating in the class of 2027 and their impact on the 2028 accountability.
