



CLSD Grant

CHS continues to implement reading interventions in grade 7, 8, and 9. The current plans includes:

- Targeting students who fall below the 40th percentile in achievement on AKSTAR or MAPs Benchmark HD Word on Fridays (15 students)
 - o 7th Grade
 - o 8th Grade
 - 9th Grade
- Partner Reading
 - 7th Grade 2 times per week Mon, Wed (12 students identified through reading inventory)
- HD Word
 - 8th Grade pull out 2 times per week (6 students)
 - 9th Grade literature circles HD Word based (6 students)
- Infercabulary
 - 7th, 8th, 9th Grade whole class (MAPs data indicates vocabulary is needed for a majority of students)

PWSRCAC - Out of Our Time Funding

CHS received funding through the Prince William Sound Citizens Advisory Council to produce a second volume of *Out of Our Time*. *Out of Our Time* is a collection of stories that were produced at CHS by students in the Discovery program in 1980. The publication focuses on the stories of Cordova locals, and is written in their own words. The book also includes local recipes and photography of the area. This second addition will focus on the stories of Cordova elders, and some of the original interviewers from *Out of Our Time*. Volume two will be compiled and produced by the Alaska Native Arts class, with editing by Ms. Pearson's AP English class. Funding was used to purchase video capture equipment, and cameras to be used in the interview and documentation process. CHS is excited for the opportunity to contribute to the preservation of Cordova history, as well as to participate in he cultivation of our next generation of writers and artists.

CHS Senior Parent Night

CHS held Senior Parent Night on September 9th. Ms. Adams presented information to parents regarding what to expect for their child's senior year, highlighted important dates, and provided anecdotal advice on how parents can support their seniors through graduation. Ms. Adams also helped parents to organize a senior parent group, and provided a list of the activities that senior parents typically organize and oversee.

Team Time #1

CHS held the first Team Time of the 2025-26 school year. Teams met in the gym where they participated in a team build. The objective was to build a "container" that would protect an egg while books were stacked upon it. The focus of the activity was to build community and climate, to encourage passion, and to model social norms. Students worked feverishly to construct their egg container as a team. Our new 7th grade students had the opportunity to work with "seasoned" team members as a community to solve a



complex problem. The winners of the competition were the Hooded Night Travelers with 38 books stacked. CHS is excited for our next Team Time in October.













MAPs Fall Benchmark

CHS completed MAPs fall benchmark testing for all 7th, 8th, and 9th grade students in Reading, Language, and Math. Results will be used in conjunction with Spring AKSTAR results to determine current student growth, and help direct academic and intervention focus. Comparative results are expected to be complete by November.

Copper River Rally

CHS hosted the 2025 Copper River Rally on September 26th and 27th. Six schools entered nine total teams in the tournament. Both Cordova varsity and junior varsity teams played well, with the Cordova varsity team placing 1st in the tournament. Of special note, Victoria Nothstine and Camila Vargas were named to the All Tournament Team, and Isabelle Nothstine was named the tournament's Most Valuable Player. Multiple coaches and referees noted how smoothly the tournament ran, and appreciated the hospitality room that was hosted by the CHS Booster Club.

CHS Cross Country

The CHS cross country team has had an outstanding season this year, with almost every runner turning in personal bests at multiple races. The team competed in the 2A regionals at Glennallen on October 26th, with Sadie Fry individually qualifying for the girls state competition, and Eli Banks, Peter Solberg, and Tage Kinsman individually qualifying for the boys state competition. The team finished 2nd overall and qualified a team of seven for the state competition as well. We're proud of the hard work and dedication our cross country team has shown, and wish our athletes good luck at state!



CHS Swimming

The CHS swim team competed in Valdez on September 19th and 20th. Although our swimmers had not yet had the opportunity to get into the water due to the pool closure in Cordova, our swimmers swam admirably, with Amelia Hottinger winning her heat with a personal best.

Pep Rally

The student council hosted the first CHS pep rally on September 24th to celebrate the cross country and swim teams. Games included a one foot balloon popping contest, and an around the world elimination contest. The senior class won the spirit stick for this quarter with the loudest cheer. The student council did a great job of putting this event together and the student body had a great time.

Site Council

CHS held the first site council of the 2025-26 school year on September 24, 2025. Agenda items included current and future intervention work at CHS, and what students do on Fridays. Parent participants had many questions about the number of students receiving interventions, and the metrics and measurements used for interventions. Other questions regarded intervention in the upper high school grades. Parent participants were also interested to learn about what students do on Fridays and had a number of questions regarding the origins of CHS's Flexible Friday schedule. A question was raised about whether or not 7:00 pm is too late for these types of meetings. We plan to explore earlier times through a possible Google survey in the Wolverine Way. The next Site Council meeting is scheduled for Thursday, October 23, with a time to be determined.
