WHEREAS, previous elections for Wichita Falls Independent School District's board members have been held annually in May;

WHEREAS, a general election will be held on November 8, 2016, by the City and County of Wichita Falls:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 271.002, Texas Election Code, political subdivisions of the State of Texas are authorized to hold elections jointly in voting precincts that can be served by common polling places if elections are ordered by the authorities of two or more political subdivisions to be held on the same day in all or part of the same territory; and

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code, Chapter 791, authorizes local governments to contract with one another and with agencies of the state for various governmental functions including those in which the contracting parties are mutually interested; and

WHEREAS, the election expenses for the Wichita Falls Independent School District, the City of Wichita Falls and Wichita County would be reduced by sharing certain costs associated with a joint election; and

WHEREAS, it would be to the benefit of the Wichita Falls Independent School District, the City of Wichita Falls, Wichita County and the citizens and voters thereof, to enter into a joint election agreement for the purpose of sharing election equipment, election officials, and facilities,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Wichita Falls Independent School District conveys its desire to enter into a joint election agreement with the City of Wichita Falls and Wichita County to be held in November. Pursuant to this agreement, current term limits for all board members will be extended for six months.
