

TSSA Plan 2024-2025

The Mission of Basin Online is to provide Uintah Basin Students with a high-quality and effective way of learning online which will prepare the student for advancement into college, career, or preparation for life experiences.

Goals:

- Students at Basin Online will increase their benchmark scores for Expressions and Equations (6-8th) and Reasoning with Equations and Inequalities (Math 1-3) 5% by quarter 3 benchmarks for the school year of 2024-2025.
- 75% of students will be actively participating in the coursework by Spring 2025 as shown by the completion of coursework.

Our plan to reach these goals includes the following strategies:

- 1. Ensure effective instruction by following DCSD's guides for pacing and proficiency.
- 2. Math teachers will provide effective and engaging math instruction on the principles of inequalities. Professional development will be provided to support teachers.

- 3. Students will be able to show their work through Kami.
- 4. Staff will work with students who are struggling and not making progress in their courses during an online power hour.
- 5. Students falling 15-20% behind in coursework will work with their advocate teacher and parents to make a plan for progress. If needed students may be placed on an Academic Success Plan with admin and progress tracked weekly. Students not passing courses will no longer be eligible for electives at boundary schools or tech schools. Students will focus on credit recovery and core classes until they are no longer credit deficient.
- 6. Summer school may be provided for students who remain credit deficient by the end of the school year 2025.
