Middle and Elementary School 2013 – 2014

Please reconsider the implementation of the following six OFYP days on the Middle and Elementary campuses for the 2013 and 2014 school year.

January 6 and 7, 2014 (Monday and Tuesday) April 10 and 11, 2014 (Thursday and Friday) May 8 and 9, 2014 (Thursday and Friday)

- In January, these days would be used to assist students who have not been successful on benchmarks and/or have had attendance problems. These are the first two days after the Christmas Holidays. This would allow us to bring students back who need that extra push and better prepare them for the second half of the school year.
- In April, these two days are before STAAR (3rd and 4th Math and Reading, 5th Science, 6th/7th Math and Reading, and 8th Science and Social Studies). We would again require our "bubble" students to attend students that need extra remediation to be successful.
- In May, these two days are extremely important for the 5th and 8th grade students who were not successful on the first administration of the Math and Reading STAAR. In these two grades, the state requires that students pass these assessments in order to be promoted to the next grade.

This school year, 2012 – 2013, we have utilized the OFYP days and they have been successful. Please reconsider allowing us to provide our struggling students with small group remediation on these days.
