Curriculum Information:

Professional Development has focused on Literacy across the grade levels with an emphasis on "The Big 5" and Individual Reading Improvement Plan **IRIP**.

DRIP/MTSS Plan was submitted to the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development on September 1. We met with each principal to discuss the implementation of all Tiers of Instruction. Training was given to most educators during the Fall Inservice on September 15.

Personnel in the Curriculum Department

Currently, three people are working in the department. The Director and the two Literacy Grant Staff Specialists. Now that the departmental assessment has been completed, a revised job description for a Program Specialist position will be developed and posted on or before September 30.

Most of the Social Studies teachers and one principal will discuss the possibility of review and adoption this year with the initial meeting held on September 18 after school.
