SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

School Board members shall be elected for a three-year term in accordance with procedures established by ordinance for municipal elections or by state regulations for regional educational attendance areas.

Any person eligible to be a voter in the district is eligible for Board membership. However, a district employee elected to the Board must resign his/her position with the District in order to qualify for Board membership.
