Please read below to find the suggested clarifications for NTH@C graduation requirements. Based on feedback we received from learners, parents and our community/business partners we felt it was necessary to make some adjustments to these expectations. Additionally, we wanted to clearly articulate the expectations for meeting this requirement. A community/business partner handbook will also be created to distribute to all hosts of NTH@C and CHS learners/students. This handbook will be a support structure to use by our community/business partners to recommend activities for their shadowees/interns to do while on the job site. This was a common concern received by our partners and this handbook will be one strategy used to alleviate this concern.

A committee of parents, facilitators, and community representatives met to review existing practices and make the following recommendations.

Current statement of Graduation Requirement:

NTH@C learners are also required to complete the following prior to graduation:

- 12 hours of college credit
- 40 hours of community service
- Digital Portfolio
- Career Experiences (Such as job shadowing and job internship experiences)
- Senior Capstone Experience

Proposed statement of Graduation requirement for freshmen class of 2009-2010 and beyond:

NTH@C learners are also required to complete the following prior to graduation:

- 12 hours of college credit
- 40 hours of community service
- Senior Capstone Project (Digital Portfolio and Career Development Experience (See structure below).
- Senior Capstone Experience
