PROGRAM SALES UPDATE -

We continue to serve more students! For the month of November we served 1,346 additional lunches over budget. This figure represents 51,317 lunches served in the district. We have experienced an increased in breakfast counts by 942 meals over budget for the month of November. This figure represents 27,111 breakfasts served in the district. We are going to launch a student survey in January to find out what elementary students like or dislike about the current offerings at breakfast.

SAFETY UPDATE -

As a continued focus on Safety, Food Service Staff reviews 5 minutes safety topics each month. Below are our topics for January:

This month, as part of the monthly Kitchen Manager Meetings our training agenda is:

- Safe Knife Handling Proper use and storage of kitchen knives.
- Cooling Food Guidelines for cooling hot food product to prevent contamination.
- Slips and Falls A fall prevention checklist to reduce accidents and injury.
- Reheating Foods Rules and guidelines for reheating food products properly and efficiently.



We will continue this school year with staff awareness, increased focus and informative training throughout the school year. Food and Nutrition Services continues to provide a safe working environment in all our schools as well as incorporating safe work place practices district wide by keeping SAFETY top of mind!

EQUIPMENT ISSUES -

The District continues to feel the strain of aging and tired equipment. From the start of the 2008-2009 school year, we have had numerous equipment failures including the dishwasher motor at Lincoln Savage, hot water heater booster at both Manzanita and Fleming, and a freezer at Williams. Total cost of repairing these items was nearly \$6,000.00. We continue to try and stay ahead by performing routine preventative maintenance in the District.
