This month in technology we have worked on the following projects:

- Worked with the OHS students issuing the new Acer devices and training them on the use and care of the devices.

- Continue discussions with potential broadband providers for the model that would best fit our situation for providing our students with constant internet access.
- Replaced faulty battery and faulty power source in OES technology room.
