Reasons for Updates

- Multipurpose Athletic Facility
- 742 fees lower than average across comparable districts/venues
- Board Policy 902 update due
- Growing number of community partnerships, requires more intentionality w/ fee structure

- **July-Aug.** - Research of facility fees & structures
- **Sept. 8th** - Draft reviewed by Community Education Advisory
- **Sept. 15th** – Facility Draft reviewed by Board Finance
- **Sept. 24th** – Board Policy Committee Reviews 902
- **Oct. 6th** – Facility Fee & Policy 902 to Board Finance
- **Oct. 15th** – Request for approval for Facility fee proposal & first read of 902

Fee Categories

Category I - First Priority- No Fee

- ISD 742 school district activities and sporting events (this includes booster led fundraising events IF funds go to district student activity accounts), community education programs, elections, special hearings, & district co-sponsored events.

Category II- Reduced Fee - 50%

- Local Non-profit- 501 (c)(3) organizations primarily serving youth attending District 742 schools & when not charging gate fees; must also be an approved district community partner.
- Local Non-profit civic groups who are an approved district community partner.

Category III- Full Price

- Local and state government entities and organizations including colleges and universities.
- All other Non-Profit Organizations, who are not an approved partner and are not verified to be serving primarily ISD 742 youth.
- Private organizations or businesses
- Private individuals
- Religious or political organizations including precinct caucuses and required legislative district or county conventions
