MIDDLE SCHOOL – 95

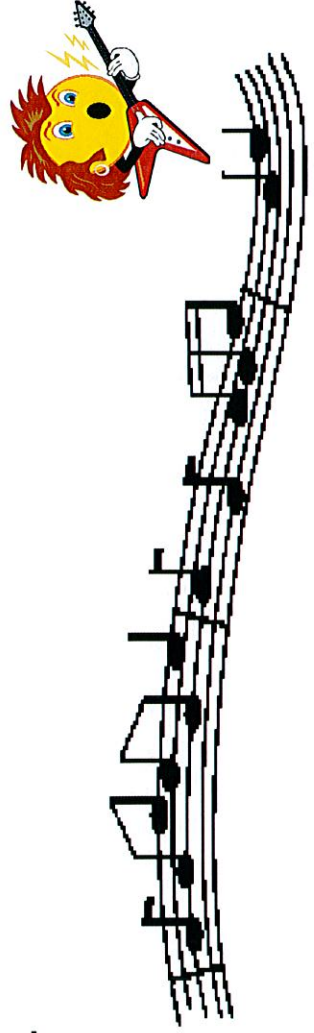

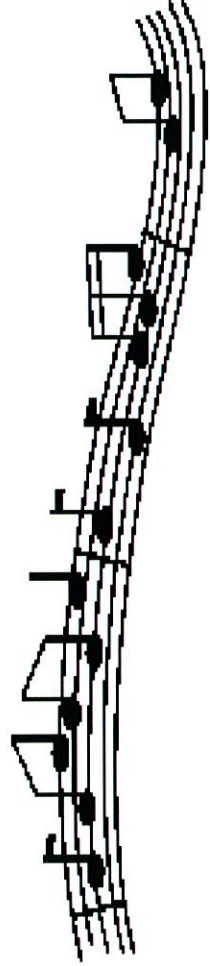

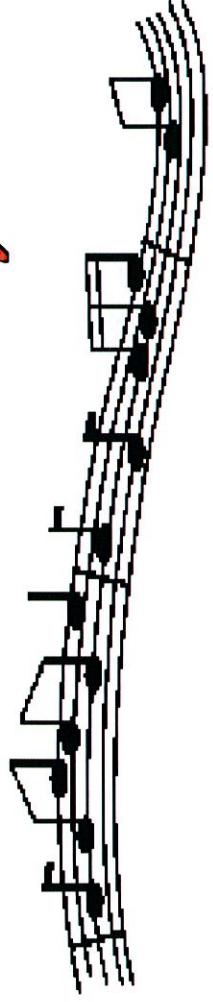
