Minidoka County School District Food Service Report September 2016

The month of September is always a little crazy with the start of school year but by the end of the month we are running fairly well. We lost one full time cook at Minico and will be interviewing Thursday October 13th to fill that position. We also will be interviewing to hire three more sub cooks.

Our claim for the month from the USDA is \$193,814.06compared to \$206,603.39 last year. We had 22 serving days in September 2015 and only 19 serving days in 2016. This amount is the total reimbursement for lunch and breakfast.

Our numbers this year for the month are down by 5,437 for lunch compared to last year and our breakfast numbers are down 3,064. However, our daily average for lunch is 2,655 servings for 2016 and 2,540 for 2015. That is an increase of 115 servings per day this year. Our daily average for breakfast shows an increase of 113 servings per day.

We would invite any members of the board to come and have lunch or breakfast with us during the school year. We thank you all for your support.
