Strategic Planning Updates

Our strategic planning team met on Thursday, October 6th to review stakeholder survey feedback related to our student, staff and family Desired Daily Experiences. Over 1,500 students, 1,000 families, and 535 staff members responded to the survey. This was considered a very good response rate.

We used the feedback to further refine our the draft desired daily experiences and to begin a draft of our theory of action.

Strategic Planning Updates

Our next three-hour session will focus on the construction of our District Vision Card. During this session, we will:

- Develop a one-page document detailing the key measures and metrics for successful implementation of the Desired Daily Experiences and what attainment of vision looks like in numbers
- District 3 Year Operational Plan of the key district initiatives and school/department projects needed for continuous improvement organized into specific Strategic Directions through 2024-2025 school year
- Reflection and refinement of Theory of Action and Desired Daily Experiences

Strategic Planning Updates

Our strategic planning efforts with Teamworks are also supported by the Regional Centers of Excellence continuous improvement efforts. Furthermore, it is important that we continue to engage stakeholders, including through tribal consultation and other outreach, to determine resource allocation of our remaining ESSER funding.

School and Community Outreach

As I mentioned in previous updates, one of my main goals for this year is to increase my time in schools and in the community to foster deeper relationships. I have been spending much more time on a weekly basis in our schools and kicked off our Education After Hours Sessions this past week. These sessions will be held in a wide variety of community centers and will also focus on intentional inclusivity of historically underrepresented voices.
