2021-22 Federal Programs Preliminary Allocations

We have received our preliminary allocations from the SDE for our Federal Programs. This is the second year in a row that we have seen a significant decrease in Title I-A funding. As previously discussed, we no longer qualify for the Title V-B Rural Education Program.
