AI Symposium

Craig and I attended the AI Symposium hosted by LEAP Innovations in partnership with the Lake County Regional Office of Education on Friday, December 5, and were pleased to see that our work is well aligned with the presenting districts. The symposium highlighted local districts' AI implementation efforts and lessons learned, emphasized the importance of integrating AI in purposeful and meaningful ways, introduced a planning protocol for effectively leveraging AI, and provided valuable opportunities to connect, share, and learn from colleagues across the region.

Stevenson High School Placement Assessments

Eighth-grade students have initiated the process of taking their Stevenson High School Placement exams. The English Language Arts (ELA) and Spanish placement exams were administered in December.

Pages and Parenting Book Study

As part of our ongoing efforts to foster a strong sense of community and engagement, the District organized a book study centered on 10 to 25: The Science of Motivating Young People by David Yeager, PhD. This marks the third year of the Pages and Parenting book club. This year, we had seven groups meet, with a total of 40 participants.

This year, I have changed the format of the book club. Rather than put parents into book club groups, I send weekly conversation prompts to spark reflection and discussion as parents read at their own pace throughout the winter. There will also be two in-person discussions on January 21 and February 19, and the PTO Parent Ed Committee will host an Author Talk Event on February 4.
