Community Engagement

- **Community Connections** We have started the design process for the Winter 2026 edition of *Community Connections*. We plan to launch winter programming by the end of November.
- **Programming Survey** We launched a google forms survey into the community for course ideas and offerings. We have already been presented with fresh new ideas through this survey.
- Social Media Presence We are in the process of creating videos to introduce office staff and promote different programs available through Community Education and Recreation. We also launched a new series called "Rec Recap" that goes over standings, achievements, and updates for K-6 athletics.

Preschool and After Care

- Fall Festival This month we will host The Pierce Lake Preschool Fall Festival. This will be a
