 - State Highway 351 that runs by HMD and FMC (anticipation for start of school and transition of ownership from State to City).
 - Fund raisers-How many? How are they monitored?

 - Teacher absences and the effect on student performance (incentives or policy changes to encourage teachers to be in the classroom more often).
