Targeted Improvement Plans for Strong Foundation Implementation School Improvement PLC Supports Grant Campuses: McNair, Resnik, and Scobee Middle Schools for 2025-2026

## 1. Background:

The Texas Education Agency offered a competitive grant opportunity to support campuses engaging in the continuous improvement process to improve outcomes for students. This grant intends to assist with school-level improvement efforts to directly benefit Comprehensive Support, Targeted Support or Additional Targeted Support identified campuses with efforts to strengthen campus systems, build staff capacity, improve school outcomes and continue implementation and/or support of their improvement efforts.

## 2. Process:

The TEA awarded McNair MS, Resnik MS, and Scobee MS the SFI School Improvement PLC Supports Grant. The District Coordinator of School Improvement (DCSI, Lisa Bolte), Principals of award campuses, and the Executive Director of Middle School Curriculum (Anitra Crisp) completed training on the School Improvement Overview. After completing the school improvement process, grant recipients must submit a Targeted Improvement Plan (TIP) to the SWISD School Board for approval. Campus Leadership Teams (CLT) worked with administrators and the DCSI and ED of MS Curriculum to collect and analyze data, and conducted a self-assessment to determine the campus implementation of the state identified essential actions. The CLT then developed an improvement plan that addresses all areas not meeting the accountability targets, and establishing goals to monitor for effectiveness. Teams worked through the continuous improvement process and developed their TIP. The DCSI and the ED of Curriculum will monitor these plans for effectiveness and implementation.
