**Please state your proposal briefly and clearly. What do you want the board to know, discuss, or decide?**

I am recommending the board adopt the draft calendar for the 2016-2017 school year - it is the calendar that reflects as much of the staff input as possible. Both unions have seen and met on the calendar, it has been vetted with the administrative team, and also the Design Grant Committee. Next school year, much like this year, is an odd year because of when Labor Day falls - it is fairly late for September, which affects what happens later in the year. There are some changes with this calendar; mainly an additional two days noted for licensed staff in the event we are successful in our grant application for a Collaboration Grant, and a modification of conferences. With the revised changes in OAR 581-022-1620, this calendar represents changes to parent conference time, as well as provides staff development time for staff to continue PLCs, analyze data, and supports continuing the collaborative work that staff are working on. This calendar also has 284 days between the start of school until the end of school, exceeding the minimum of 265 days required by ODE. There are structures in place, should the District be successful with it's Collaboration Grant application, that will support the activities designed by the Design Grant Committee without requiring further changes. This calendar does require an exception to be made by OSEA to the holiday language of the collective bargaining agreement due to where New Year's Day falls; without that exception, school would resume on Tuesday, January 2, students would finish on Friday, June 16, and licensed staff would finish on Monday, June 19.

**Provide history/background information on your proposal.**

I have provided a summary of changes in requirements below for your consideration:

**List the advantages of your proposal:**

We would start after Labor Day, much like most districts in our region and across the state. We preserve the week of Thanksgiving off, which is also a clear desire of many of our staff and of many of our families, and we are able to end at the end of the second full week of June, and not have to have staff return on Monday, June 19.

**List possible disadvantages of your proposal:**

Having parent conferences right before Thanksgiving break might influence turn-out unless schools actively work to contact parents and engage them in attending. With the way the quarter ends and where Veterans' Day falls, it is difficult to find a week to schedule parent conferences that month that doesn't cause some kind of a potential conflict.
