CALL TO ORDER

Board Vice-Chair Fischer-Maki called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Woodland Charter School (WCS) Public Hearing – Charter Renewal

- Superintendent Valenzuela explained how the charter renewal process works, which includes this opportunity for the Board to hear from Woodland CS and an opportunity for public to comment on the charter renewal.
- Woodland CS Education Director Chris Carmiencke shared a slide deck with information on the following:
 - Their goal which included a 10-year charter renewal, 88% pass through rate, continued partnerships with TRSD services and support with facility growth including the hope to purchase the land from TRSD.
 - Expressed gratitude to TRSD for support from TRSD.
 - Shared what you might not know about Woodland (Handwork, social emotional learning, whole child focus, family involvement, media policy, enrollment stats).
 - Opportunities for growth in the next ten years

- Board Policies First Reading
 - Director Allen-Hart brought forward the following policies for the first reading:

 - Updates and changes to the policies are based on recommendations from the OSBA and by state and federal law.

ACTION ITEMS

• SOESD Local Service Plan

- Superintendent Valenzuela reported that this Local Service Plan is brought to the board annually for approval. The ESD provides services to us for technology and infrastructure support. In years past we relied heavily on them for Special Education services, but the ESD is working to modify their services to meet the needs of school districts. He encouraged the board to approve the Local Service Plan as presented.
- Member Searle made a motion to accept the SOESD Local Service Plan as presented. Member Wright seconded the motion. There was discussion. Board Vice-Chair Fischer-Maki called for a vote and the motion passed 3-0 (Members Johnstun and Halsted absent).

• Planned Course Statement – Beginning Band

- Deputy Superintendent Alderson explained the planned course statement is an update to course we already offer but needed updating with the course description and course goals.
- Member Wright made a motion to adopt the beginning band planned course statement. Member Searle seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously (3-0).

Obsolete Policy Removal

- Superintendent Valenzuela reported that we have another set of policies for removal and explained how we got to this. The district leadership team reviewed each of these policies and made sure it was either covered by another policy, or an obsolete topic.
- Member Wright made a motion to delete the presented list of obsolete policies. Member Searle seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously (3-0).

• Classified Employee Appreciation Week – March 6-10, 2023

- Board Vice-Chair Fischer-Maki shared that the backbone of what takes place every single day are our classified employees. She then read the resolution recognizing classified staff and designating March 6-10, 2023, as Classified Employee Appreciation Week.
- Member Wright made a motion to approve the resolution as read. Member Searle seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.
