WHEN: Summer 2008, 4 Week Half-Day Program

June 9-July 3

WHERE: Wylie Elementary and Wylie Junior High School

WHO: Pre-Kindergarten through Sixth grade

(Approximately 75 students)

PURPOSE: To improve reading & math skills and self esteem.

This camp is designed to teach and improve reading and math skills of at-risk Pre-Kindergarten through Sixth grade students. The primary goals of Wylie Summer Reading & Math Camp are:

- 1. Improve reading & math skills through a variety of activities.
- 2. Improve self esteem by providing students with opportunities for success.
- 3. Promote a love of reading.

Students will be identified by their classroom teachers based on the following criteria:

- 1. Standardized Test Results.
- 2. Report Card Grades.
- 3. Title I Identification.
- 4. Parent/Teacher Recommendation.
