- Reading scores are lower than math at each grade level.


Potential Problems

- Reading- the rigor of ELA instruction
- Training and experience with curriculum resources- new resources and new staff

Action Plan

- Revise the assessment plan to include more specific guidelines for testing administration
 - Take age into consideration (Ex.- Kindergarten and 1st administer in small groups)
- Implementation of Wit and Wisdom with literacy coaching and additional professional learning throughout the year

- Number Corner implementation with instructional coaching support
- Development of Eureka Math implementation guide, coaching, engaging teachers in classroom walkthroughs
