Wilson on TBEC Honor Roll for third consecutive year

Wilson Elementary School has been named one of the top elementary schools in the state by the Texas Business and Education Coalition. This is the third consecutive year, and fourth time in the past five years, that Wilson has received this honor.

The TBEC identifies its Honor Roll by analyzing three years of performance data for every public school in Texas. A TBEC Honor Roll school must have a high percentage of students meeting state standards on every section of the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills for three consecutive years.

Less than four percent of more than 8,000 public schools in the state are bestowed this honor.

TBEC schools on the Honor Roll have the highest percentage of students performing at the state's most rigorous standard commended in every subject. The selection criteria also accounts for the school's demographics, number of subjects tested and students per grade level.

Wilson Elementary, a Title 1 school, was named an "Exemplary" campus by the Texas Education Agency on July 30, 2010.

Gold Performance Acknowledgments

The Texas Education Agency is recognizing Denton Independent School District's elementary and secondary schools for their significant gains on different portions of the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills test and other accountability areas with Gold Performance Acknowledgments.

Denton ISD schools were honored with 73 total GPAs, a sign that the district is consistently achieving a high level of academic performance. Denton ISD's total number of awarded GPAs has more than doubled in the past four school years.
