8th Grade Presidential Awards:

- President's Award for Academic Achievement: Criteria for this includes maintaining a 3.5 GPA for all three years of middle school as well as at least one MAP score per year that places the student in the 85th percentile or above in math or reading. This year 7 students were awarded this honor.
- President's Award for Academic Excellence: Criteria for this award is the same as outlined above except the students must have one MAP score each year that ranks them in the 85th percentile or above in reading and math. This year 3 students were awarded this honor.

eCybermission:
