- Summer School for at risk students in grades 2<sup>nd</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> grade was held during the 1<sup>st</sup> 3 weeks of June. We served 44 students in Math, Reading/LA, and Science. Attendance was great.
- BISD hosted Get Fit Brackettville Camp from June 23<sup>rd</sup> thru July 16<sup>th</sup>. The camp was under the direction of 4 University of Texas Health and Science Center students. The university hired 20 of our High School students to serve as camp counselors. The Camp served approximately 114 six thru twelve year olds in our community. The curriculum included Wellness and Nutrition Lessons, Fitness Games, Arts and Crafts, Swimming 3 times per week, Talent Show, and a field trip to Garner State Park. The directors hosted a banquet for where three of our High School students were awarded I-Pods and 5 of them were awarded the Llano Program (Learn, Lead, And Advance Opportunities) where they will get to spend 1 week at the University of Texas in San Antonio and get handson experience in the field of Health and Science.
- Our TAKS results are back from the 3<sup>rd</sup> administration. We had a total of 14 fifth grade students taking the Math TAKS and 6 taking the Reading TAKS. We also had one 3<sup>rd</sup> grader taking the Reading TAKS. The results are as follows:

3 <sup>rd</sup> Grade Reading		1 didn't pass
5 <sup>th</sup> Grade Reading	3 students passed	3 didn't pass
5 <sup>th</sup> Grade Math	6 students passed	8 didn't pass

As a result, the 3<sup>rd</sup> grader will be placed in 4<sup>th</sup> grade per ARD. 6 of the 5<sup>th</sup> graders will be retained and 2 will be placed in 6<sup>th</sup> grade; all with accelerated instruction in place.
