





There were 23 students who met their math goal, and 23 met their reading goal.




There were 7 students who met their Math goal, and 6 met their Reading goal.







There were 47 students who met their Math goal, and 49 met their Reading goal.




There were 48 students who met their Language goal, 31 met their Math goal, and 44 met their Reading goal.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students read 3,010 books, up from last year's 620 books, and 4<sup>th</sup> grade read 2,390 books, up from last year's 1,940 books. This year the students read 9,030 books compared to last year's total of 6,060 books. The students read 2,970 more books this year!!
