Saturday, June 11:

6:30 A.M. Bus Arrives at Fleming. Please do not arrive before 6:30.

7:00 A.M. Bus departs Fleming.

-We will make several stops on the way to six flags including rest stops, gas and snack stops.

12:00 P.M. Arrive at Vallejo California.

Spend 12:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. at Six Flags. We will meet several times throughout the day as a group to check in.

8:00 P.M. Meet in the front of the park. Return to bus as a group.

8:30 P.M. Depart for Dinner at In and Out Burger.

!0:00 P.M. Depart for Grants Pass. We will stop at rest areas as needed.

Sunday:

5:30 A.M. Arrive at Fleming. We will begin calling parents when we get to Rogue River.

Rules:

- 1. All school rules.*
- 2. Stay in groups of three or more.
- 3. Do not leave the park.
- 4. All media must be G or PG rated.

Cost:

The cost of the trip for parents and students is \$75.00. This covers the cost of the bus as well as admission. Students will need to bring additional money for food and purchases. The money for the trip is due by Friday, May 13th.
