Re: Vandagriff Assistant Principal

We are excited to announce Heather Street as our recommendation for the 2015-2016 Vandagriff Elementary Assistant Principal.

At the March 16, 2015 Board meeting it was approved to move from a part time assistant principal for Vandagriff to a full time assistant principal position. The position was posted and we had eighty-six candidates apply who met the minimum and preferred requirements that include a Master's degree, the appropriate administrator certification, and a minimum of three years as a classroom teacher. From this pool of eighty-six applicants, seventeen were given a phone interview screener. Eight individuals were then invited in for a formal interview that consisted of a three person interview team. We conducted full reference checks on the eight applicants. Six applicants (two internal, four external) were approved for the AP pool for the Vandagriff principal to consider and conduct a second round of interviews before making her recommendation to the superintendent.

Heather Street's educational background includes:

- A Bachelor of Science in Biology/Criminal Justice from the Texas Christian University
- A Master of Education Administration from Tarleton State University

Heather Street's career highlights:

- Three years as a 5th grade science teacher at Western Hills Elementary where she was promoted to Lead Science Teacher
- Five years as the Lead Behavioral Specialist at Luella Merrett Elementary
- Hired in 2014 as Aledo ISD's District Behavioral Intervention Specialist
