- 3. Priscilla Maxwell and Amanda Skinner have been added as a mentor in the class. They both have limited Spanish proficiency, but are able to assist.
- 4. We ordered textbooks to distribute to the students so they are not totally reliable on technology.
- 5. A Google Form has been set up that allows for real time assistance from Cathy Jones, Amanda Skinner and Priscilla Maxwell.
- 6. We are exploring options for offering tutoring during study hall. This is not finalized.

I would like to recognize the work of Cathy Jones, Priscilla Maxwell, Amanda Skinner and Scott Savage as they work extensively to assist our students.

Open House was held in person on Aug.26th. The total number of visits were 228.

Financial Aid night will be hosted by Mrs. Maxwell on September 21st from 5:00-6:00pm.

Picture Day will be September 29th.

PHS staff has donated over \$730 to be split between the United Way and the Faculty Club! Teachers wishing to wear jeans on Fridays contribute to these great causes.
