


FSVA Mission



Expanded Learning Opportunities

FSVA will....

- Reach FSPS-zoned students who do not currently attend a FSPS school (homeschool, private school)
- Extend to students outside FSPS via school choice (transportation would not be provided for students outside FSPS boundaries)
- Serve school and community simultaneously
- Allow students to continue participation in extracurricular activities in their zoned schools or, if attending through school choice, their designated school of choice

Goals

Academic

• 80% of FSVA students will meet or exceed state averages in Language Arts and Mathematics, as measured by the annual state assessments.

Career Readiness

• 90% of FSVA students will meet or exceed personal goals developed to support college/career readiness.

Community Involvement

 80% of FSVA students will participate in community service learning and, beginning in middle schools, field experiences to increase exposure in various industries for the purpose of connecting to future career fields.






