


FROM OUR SPECIALS TEAM

EMERGENCY DAY LEARNING INFORMATION

District 33 schools occasionally close during extreme summer and winter weather. When possible, the administration

will make every attempt to determine and communicate school closings by 5:30 AM on the affected day. If there is a school closure, the D33 administration may have students participate in asynchronous learning from home instead of canceling classes. Asynchronous instruction is when students learn on their own with packets provided by the district. On Friday, November 8, 2024, your child brought home Emergency Learning Day packets for Day 1 and Day 2. Please keep these packets in a safe place. If the district decides to implement an Emergency Learning Day, students will use the packet for independent work. If your child did not receive the packets, please contact the school.
