Food Service Building Report

The Food Service Program total meals served to students for May 2025 are below (19 days)

Breakfast: 16,208 meals Lunches: 24,523 meals Supper Program: 1,859 meals

The last day for supper program was be May 27t^h and will resume September 2nd after Labor Day. The CACFP program allows supper program to operate September 1st – May 31st, and summers are not allowed through the summer program.

The Ware house has been working very hard daily to carry out their daily operations including the assistance they provide for the school kitchens, food deliveries, and mail. The warehouse clerks and the cooks that are subbing for the summer season have packed the food service warehouse for the upcoming move to the new building. We are now waiting for the go ahead to move.

The food service program does have vacancies; (2) assistant cooks at Napi kitchen.

The Napi kitchen is the Central kitchen for summer program for summer food program. The kitchen had extreme use throughout the school year with supper program included. The food service staff has started to deep clean the kitchen. At this time, we have not received the new equipment (warmer/salad bar server). The county sanitarian inspection report is attached.

At this time, the copy center temporary closed for packing and the upcoming move. The last day for copy orders was on June 6th. The copy center will have a part-time clerk for the summer season.

The summer food program started on June 9th and is in full swing.

The food service program looks forward to feeding the kids and happy tummies!
