Item Name: CONSIDER APPROVAL OF LOW-ATTENDANCE WAIVER FOR OCTOBER 8, 2025

Item Summary: On Tuesday, October 7, 2025, threatening language was discovered written on the wall of a restroom at Fulshear High School. Ammunition was also discovered in one of the toilets of the restroom. Campus administration and district police investigated and cleared the campus. Parents were notified of the situation and assured that there was not any indication of an active threat and that additional security would be available the following day.

As a result, Fulshear High School attendance on Wednesday, October 8, 2025, dropped to 71.06% compared to the 2024-2025 campus average of 94.80%.

Texas Education Agency's (TEA) Student Attendance Accounting Handbook (SAAH) allows campuses experiencing a decline in attendance on a specific day of 10% or greater due to weather, health, or safety related issues to request a Low-Attendance Waiver. If approved, the waiver will exclude the impacted day from attendance calculations so there is not a negative impact on funding.

Recommendation: Administration recommends that the Board of Trustees authorize the Superintendent to submit a Low-Attendance Waiver to exclude Wednesday, October 8, 2025 attendance for Fulshear High School.
