Chris,

I am requesting that next policy meeting have the following language added to the agenda ,

Craig Public School District employees may not direct or otherwise compel a student to personally affirm, adopt, or adhere to, or provide a course of instruction or unit of study that directs or otherwise compels a student to affirm, adopt, or adhere to, the following tenets:

- a given sex, race, ethnicity, religion, color, or national origin is inherently superior or inferior;
- (2) an individual should be treated adversely based on the individual's sex, race, ethnicity, religion, color, or national origin;
- (3) an individual, by virtue of the individual's sex, race, ethnicity, religion, color, or national origin, is inherently responsible for actions committed in the past by other members of the same sex, race, ethnicity, religion, color, or national origin.
- (b) CCSD may not provide a course of instruction or unit of study that teaches, the curriculum, in part or in whole, described by the New York Times' 1619 Project.

I am also making the same request concerning the agenda for the next CCSD Board meeting.
