

# SHS Campus Improvement Plan 2016-2017 Summary

- Implement Drug testing program for students involved in extracurricular activities at SHS.
- Issue student parking passes.
- College Mondays to promote College Awareness
- Provide technology staff development to teachers to prepare for 1:1 environment in fall of 2017.
- Provide a consultant to work with the math department to focus on TEKS alignment and increase test scores.
- Partner with Ranger College to offer certification programs - Certified Nursing Assistant, Certified Medical Assistant, Emergency Medical Services, Welding (dual credit opportunities + certification)
- Continue to offer dual credit opportunities - Dual Credit Algebra
- Coordinate “Fun Monday” to provide students with opportunities: Socialize with friends, tutoring/homework, club meetings, college rep presentations, counselor contact, karaoke, fantasy sports, fun videos, musical instruments, book club, crafts, etc.
- Coordinate Shattered Dreams Program - a comprehensive, educational program designed to promote responsible decision making among high school students regarding underage drinking and impaired driving (driving after drinking or riding with a drunk driver) by showing them how irresponsible choices can end all dreams. Includes School Administration, Faculty, Students, Parents, Community Organizations, Law Enforcement, Emergency Medical Services and hospital.
