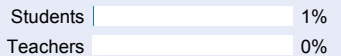

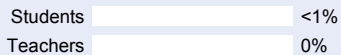

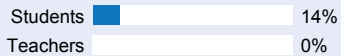

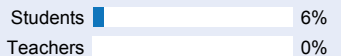

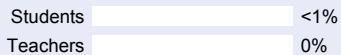

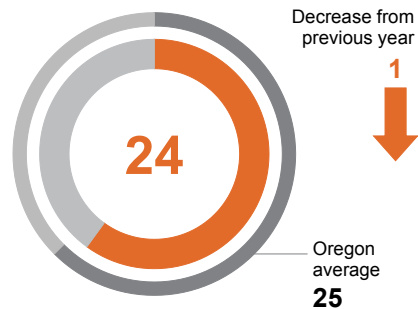

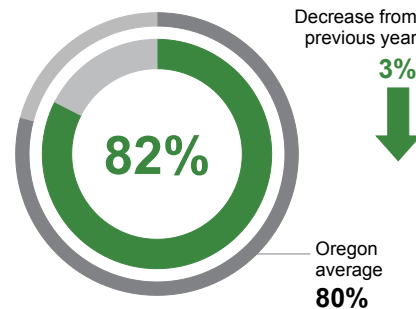
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

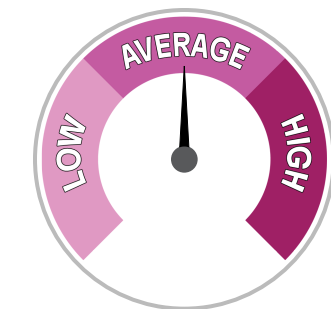
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

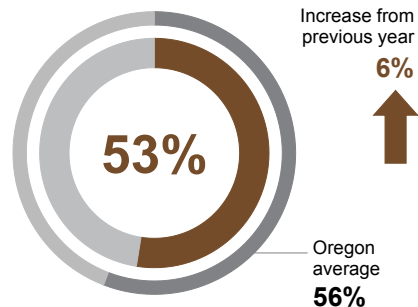
Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.

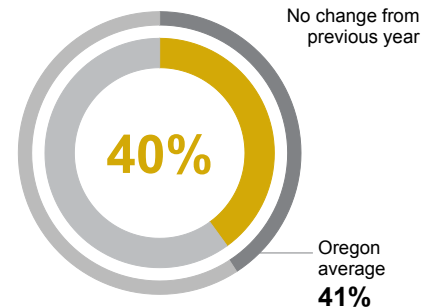
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



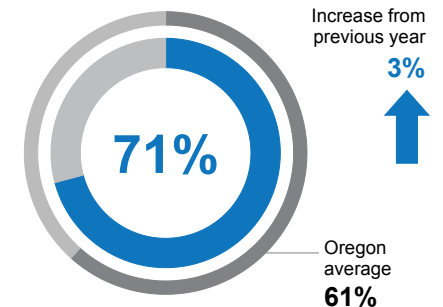
MATHEMATICS

School Goals

Positive Relationships: Sunridge staff strive to connect and build positive relationships with all students. Research indicates that students who have a positive relationship with an adult attend school more often, have minimal behavioral issues and ultimately perform better academically.

Literacy: Sunridge staff implement literacy strategies across content areas. Additionally, literacy support classes are imbedded into the school schedule for students who need additional support and instruction in reading.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is working in partnership with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

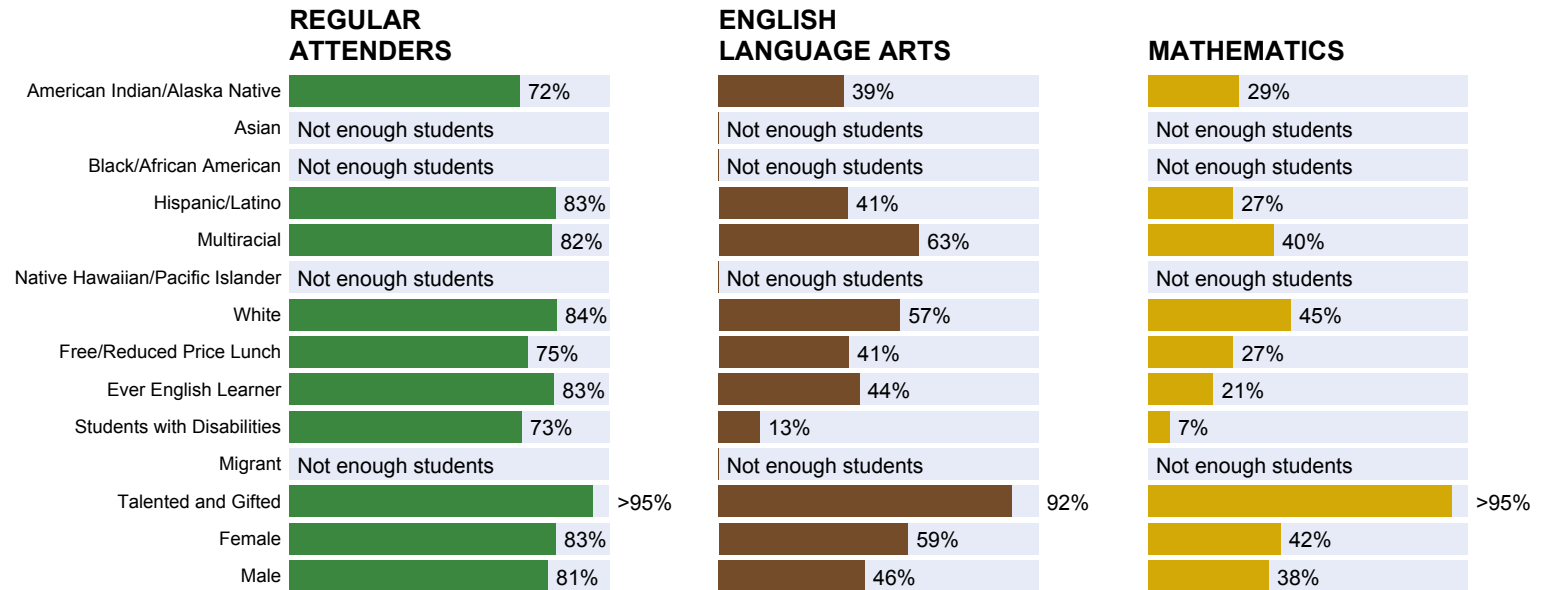

BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

To ensure a safe and nurturing school environment for everyone, our school utilizes an advisory program with lessons to focus on positive choices and minimize disruptive and negative behavior. Our school also utilizes an anonymous online reporting system, SafeOregon, allowing students, staff, parents or community members the ability to report concerns. Our school community works with students and parents on a case-by-case basis to address conflict and mistreatment along with supporting students to learn how to interact appropriately in all school settings.
