In compliance with the requirements of the *No Child Left Behind* statute the Three Rivers School District informs parents that you may request information about the professional qualifications of your student's teacher(s). The following information may be requested:

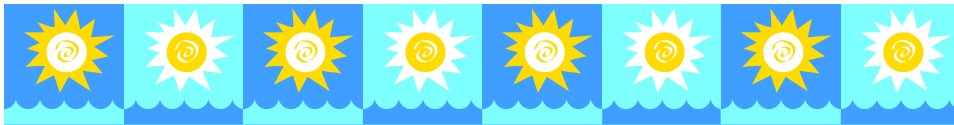
whether the teacher has met the Oregon Department of Education's requirements for certification for the grade level and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;

whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or other provisional status through which Oregon qualifications or certification criteria have been waived;

the college major and any graduate certification or degree held by the teacher;

whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications.

Education of All Disabled Children/ Young Adults

Public Law 105.17 known as I.D.E.A. (Individualized Disability Education Act) requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children/young adults ages 0 to 21.

Three Rivers School District requests the identification of any disabled children/young adults between the ages of 0 to 21, who are not enrolled or currently being served by the district schools.
