Welcome to this October's edition of the Principal's Corner for the 2014/15 school year. I cannot believe we have already been in school for four weeks. It seems as if the weather has finally changed and fall activities are now in full swing. I love the start of school as there is a buzz around campus and in our community with all that we are able to enjoy with the beginning of another school year.


Each beginning of the month features a new school newsletter. Each newsletter communicates important information on teaching and learning, school events, activities, and deadlines here at Hidden Valley High School. Likewise my writing will touch on important school related topics and themes that affect the lives of our kids. I hope you find each month's newsletter informative and worthwhile.

Last December, as many of you know, we had secured a grant from the Community Sports Development Council to place professional grade field turf in all three of our outside fields. There was one hurdle that we needed to clear in order to secure funding. We had to garner a \$685,000 commitment from our community that included both cash and in-kind from our community. I am very proud to report to all that we have raised \$635,000 worth of matching monies to complete both the football/soccer field and the baseball field. We need to continue to fundraise an additional \$50,000 over the next nine months to finish the softball field. In addition to these upgrades (which are absolutely amazing), our facilities committee has secured over \$35,000 in excavation site prep and funding to start the process of building six tennis courts. This project will cost around \$100,000 as our plans are one that will transform opportunities with tennis here in the Rogue Valley. Finally, I would like everyone to know that our stadium account has enough money to build bathrooms that will service all four facilities. The baseball field will be excavated in the next couple of weeks and the tennis courts, bathrooms, and softball field will be started and completed next summer. Currently, we have a Mustang 50 fundraiser going on to help securing the kind of help we need. If you are interested in any way of helping complete this vision, please contact my office and visit with either Mr. Miller or myself.

Our football/soccer field dedication will be on October 17<sup>th</sup> during halftime of the football game. I would like to personally invite each of you to come and be part of this special evening. Our community has given so much of their time and resources to see phase one of this project to fruition... it is time to celebrate as we enter a new era here at Hidden Valley- one where we can say to the whole region.... Our kids deserve the best and are playing on the safest and most amazing athletic surfaces in the world. I hope you can join us.


