The Texas Education Agency released preliminary campus and district results for the 2017-18 school year on August 15, 2018. Information was released through the website: [txschools.org](http://txschools.org)

This year almost every district in the state of Texas received a Letter Grade for each of the 3 Domains in the Accountability Framework and for the Overall Rating.

1. Student Achievement Domain
2. School Progress Domain
3. Closing the Gaps Domain

Campuses received a “Met Standard” or “Improvement Required” Standard for each of the 3 Domains and the Overall Rating.

### UNDERSTANDING OVERALL PERFORMANCE



This report card is designed to tell us how well we are helping students reach grade level and how well we are preparing them for success after high school. #### STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

The Closing the Gaps domain tells us how well different populations of students in a district are performing.
