

Denton Independent School District
Strickland MS ActivPanel & Extron WallVault Purchase

February 9, 2021

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from ProComputing Corporation in the amount of \$268,215.63 for the purchase and installation of Promethean ActivPanel displays and Extron WallVault units for phase 2 campus renovations of Strickland Middle School.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

The Board of Trustees previously approved the Districtwide Classroom Display and A/V Refresh Project Purchase on December 10, 2019. The Board of Trustees previously approved the purchase of Promethean ActivPanel displays for phase 1 campus renovations of Strickland Middle School in the amount of \$282,358.00 on March 24, 2020.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This purchase will provide Promethean ActivPanel displays for the classrooms and common areas located in phase two of the campus renovations that are scheduled to be turned over to the District in both April and July 2021. The quoted list of Promethean ActivPanel displays was reviewed and accepted by Kathleen Carmona, Principal, Strickland Middle School.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The ActivPanels and Extron WallVault units will be purchased through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative (TIPS). This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne by this project's 2018 Bond Authorization budget.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order the Promethean ActivPanel displays in time to be installed for the 2021-2022 school year.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the quote from ProComputing Corporation in the amount of \$268,215.63 for the purchase and installation of Promethean ActivPanel displays and Extron WallVault units for phase 2 campus renovations of Strickland Middle School be approved.
