NCLB School Choice Option

Rationale/Purpose

The federal No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) requires that any school not making adequate yearly progress (AYP) for two consecutive years must offer students the choice of attending another school in the district that is making AYP.

Implementation

Schools not making AYP for two consecutive years will notify the parents of students in the school of that fact by the beginning of the school year. Choice of transferring to another school, however, will not be an option because there is no other school in each grade span in the district for students to transfer to. Actions being taken to help all students make AYP will be covered in the notification to parents.
